Board Member Profile: Rev Michael Whiting

Michael Whiting is an Anglican priest and until May 2006 was the Deputy Headmaster of St Peter's College (an Anglican boys' school) in Adelaide. Michael has studied at the University of Sydney (B.A., Dip.Ed., M.Ed) and the University of New England (M.Ed.Admin). He also has a Diploma in Theology. He taught from 1970 to 1973 at Sydney Boys High School.



From 1975 to 1985, Michael was on the staff of Loreto College Marrayatville, and for most of that time was Deputy Principal. From 1985 to 1992, he was the Principal of Girton College, Bendigo, an Anglican co-educational day and boarding school. Michael was ordained in 1990 and became the Chaplain at St Peter's College in 1993.

Michael and Janine (a teacher-librarian) have three adult children: Matthew, (ex Senior Tutor, St Mary's College) an astrophysicist with the CSIRO in Sydney; Linden (ex Loreto, Marrayatville) a Visual Arts teacher at Loreto Kirribilli and Julian, an environmental engineer with the Murray-Darling Basin Commission in Canberra.

In 1995, Michael was invited to serve a term on the School Council of Loreto, Marrayatville, and in 2004 was invited to join the Loreto Education Board.
